GIRISH AGNIHOTRI, J. (Oral)

Petitioner – Smt. Sarli Devi stated to be aged 60 years has filed the present writ petition *inter alia* with a prayer to direct the respondent No.2 to appoint and approve the faculty of the petitioner institute in terms of letter of intent issued by the National Council for Teachers Education on 13.09.2018 (Annexure P-7), thereby giving permanent recognition; with further prayer to take action on the representations moved by the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner makes reference to order dated 30.10.2018 passed by this Court in CWP No.26416 of 2018. He then submits that the petitioner society had made a representation to the Director, SCERT, Gurugram, Haryana, for approval of teaching staff for D.EL.Ed. Course of SMC College of Education, Tehsil Narnaul, District Mahendergarh. He further submits that in fact this request was made by the petitioner in order to comply with the condition imposed by National

Council for Teachers Education and to get the recognition. In this regard, the petitioner had already got notice published in two national newspapers. Learned counsel however, submits that the time of 60 days are likely to expire in few days from today. He, therefore, prays for time bound directions to the authorities concerned to decide the representations dated 10.03.2021 and 25.03.2021 (Annexure P5 and P6) respectively.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of Court, Ms. Palika Monga, DAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents-State.

In view of the above and without commenting on the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2, to consider the representations dated 10.03.2021 and 25.03.2021 (Annexure P-5 and P6) respectively, and decide the same in accordance with law, as expeditiously as possible, preferably within a period of 07 days from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.

Ordered accordingly.
