The Court has been convened through video conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

Instant petition has been filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of Habeas Corpus for directing the release of detenues named in para No.6 of the petition, who have been illegally detained in the brick kiln by respondent Nos.4 to 6.

Vide order dated 16.03.2020, this Court had directed the appointment of a Warrant Officer to visit the place of detention of the alleged detenues and get them released, as also to file a report before this Court. In compliance of the said order, report dated 18.03.2020 has been received, wherein it has been submitted that all the illegally detained

persons have been released and the statement of the petitioner has been recorded, which has also been placed on the record with the report.

In view of the above development, the petition is rendered infructuous and is dismissed as such.
