Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

The present petition has been filed by the petitioner for giving directions to the respondents to decide the objections of the petitioners (Annexure P2 to P5) dated 30.03.2021.

Brief facts are that on 22.03.2021, the respondent No.1 issued notification (Annexure P1) with regard to new wardwandi of Nagar Council Sangrur and inviting objections from the public. The petitioners have sent the objections through email.

Learned State counsel has informed that after issuing notification (Annexure P1) dated 22.03.2021, seven days notice was given for filing objections. Eight objections were received. File was put up for deciding the objections on 30.03.2021. These objections were decided on 31.03.2021 and thereafter, the final notification was issued on 31.03.2021. After issuing of final notification, the

petitioner can challenge the final notification in accordance with law. He further

states that objections were invited within seven days and beyond seven days, none of the objections have been accepted by the Department for decision.

However, learned counsel for the petitioners states that there were government holidays from 27.03.2021 to 29.03.2021.

However, the initial notification (Annexure P1) was issued on 22.03.2021 and there was sufficient time for the petitioner for filing objections. Since the petitioners have given the objections on 30.03.2021 which is delayed beyond seven days as per the notification (Annexure P1), no cause of action arises in the present writ petition.

The present writ petition is dismissed.
