Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.244 dated 31.12.2019 under Sections 420, 120-B IPC, registered at Police Station Lopoke, District Amritsar Rural.

While granting interim bail to the petitioner, following order was passed by this Court on 19.03.2020: -

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the matter stands compromised between the parties and the petitioner has already filed a petition bearing CRM-M-3619-2020 seeking quashing of FIR on the basis of the compromise, in which notice of motion has been issued for 27.08.2020...”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that in compliance of the aforesaid order, the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for further investigation. It is further submitted that a period of about 01 year and 07 months has passed and there is no complaint against the petitioner that he has misused the concession of interim anticipatory bail. It is also submitted that the matter stands compromised between the parties and in CRM-M-3619-2020, statements of the parties have already been recorded in support of the compromise.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Angrej Singh, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, this petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner vide order dated 19.03.2020 is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438 (2) Cr.P.C.
