This is a petition filed on behalf of the petitioner for regular bail under Section 439 Cr.P.C. in case FIR No.19 dated 01.03.2021, under Sections 323/34 of the IPC (Section 308 of the IPC added), registered at Police Station Cantt. Bathinda.

[2]. Ld. Counsel for the complainant submits that the complainant has compromised the dispute with the petitioner.

[3]. Investigation is still in progress. However, no actual grievous injury is seen to have been inflicted on the person of the complainant/victim.

[4]. In view thereof, without commenting any further on the merits of the present case as a whole, but in view of the detention undergone by the petitioner, since 02.03.2021, and the fact that the trial is likely to take its

own considerable time to complete due to ongoing covid-19 pandemic, as such, the prayer of the petitioner for regular bail is allowed and he is ordered to be released on bail, subject to appropriate terms and conditions to the satisfaction of the Ld. Trial Court/Duty Magistrate, concerned.
