The defendants-petitioners have assailed the correctness of an interlocutory order passed by the learned Additional Civil Judge (Senior Division), Rewari, while refusing to stay the subsequent suit but at the same time ordered the clubbing of both the suits. The court has found that some of the parties are not common. Still further, in both the cross suits the respective plaintiffs have prayed for grant of decree for permanent injunction.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, this Bench does not find it appropriate to exercise its jurisdiction under Article 227 of the Constitution of India.

Hence, dismissed.
