[1] Learned State Counsel on instructions from *SI Kuljit Kaur* states that despite opportunity having been granted to the petitioner, he has not co-operated in the same and has not handed over his mobile phone.

[2] Faced with the aforementioned submission, learned counsel for the petitioner prays for permission to withdraw the instant petition with liberty to the petitioner to surrender before the learned trial Court, to move a petition for regular bail and directions being issued to the learned trial Court to consider and decide the same, in a time bound manner.

[3] The same is not opposed to by the learned State Counsel.

[4] Accordingly, in view of the statement of learned counsel for the parties but without commenting upon the merits of the case, the instant petition is dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty, as prayed for. In the eventuality of the petitioner moving a petition for regular bail, the learned trial Court is directed to consider and decide the same in accordance with law by taking into account all aspects of the matter, as expeditiously as possible.
