Prayer in this writ petition is for setting aside communication dated 26.2.2021 wherein petitioner's claim for financial assistance to her destitute children was denied.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from Rohit Sharma, ADA, Department of Social Justice, submits that petitioner's claim is being considered and that the department of Social Justice and Empowerment has decided to normalize the pension ID No.5585488 of the petitioner's

destitute child as well as grant arrear of the petitioner's destitute child. Copy of letter dated 22.7.2021 from the Director General, Social Justice and Empowerment Department, Haryana, Chandigarh has been circulated on the WhatsApp group created for the purpose of video conferencing. Print out of the same be taken and attached with the file.

Keeping in view the specific stand of the respondent/department, no further orders are called for. In view of the stand taken by the department as above, petitioner's claim be finally satisfied within six weeks
