The matter has been taken up through video conferencing.

The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for the grant of anticipatory bail in FIR No.48 dated 10.02.2021 registered under Section 323, 34, 365 IPC (Sections 148, 506, 149 IPC and Section 25 of Arms Act added later on), at Police Station Chandimandir, District Panchkula Haryana.

The petitioners are being prosecuted for having kidnapped the complainant's husband and then giving him beatings as also getting a video made from him with regard to showing of co-accused Yadwinder Singh's company in good light.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners have been falsely implicated in this case due to professional rivalry between the co-accused Yadwinder Singh and the complainant's husband; the petitioners have no other criminal case pending against them; the petitioners are not named in the FIR and that under the interim orders passed by this Court, the petitioners have joined the investigation.

Learned State counsel submits that under the interim orders passed by this Court, the petitioners have joined the investigation,

cooperated with the same and that their custodial interrogation is not required.

After considering the totality of the above facts and in particular the statement made by learned State counsel that under the interim orders passed by this Court, the petitioners have joined investigation; cooperated with the same and that their custodial interrogation is not required by the State, the interim order of this Court dated 23.04.2021, granting ad interim anticipatory bail to the petitioners is made absolute.
