Case taken up through video conferencing.

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No.239 dated 16.06.2020, under Sections 307, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, besides Sections 25 and 27 of the Arms Act, 1959, registered at Police Station Goindwal Sahib, District Tarn Taran.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the incident is the outcome of a sudden quarrel between youngsters playing football and the petitioner is not attributed any injury. He also contends that only three firearm injuries are alleged to have been caused to the injured by co-accused Simranjit Singh and Nirmal Singh, who had come on a motorcycle. The petitioner is 23 years of age. He further contends that the similarly situated co-accused, namely, Daljeet Singh has been granted anticipatory bail by this Court by order

dated 01.03.2021 passed in CRM-M No. 4138 of 2021.

This Court, by the order dated 22.04.2021, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from SI Tarsem Singh, states that although the petitioner has joined investigation but recovery has to be effected from him.

In view of the above and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 22.04.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
