Learned counsel for the petitioners has contended that in compliance with the order dated 19.03.2020, the petitioners have since joined the investigation and have been released on interim bail. Therefore, the present petition be accepted.

Ld. State counsel, on instructions from ASI Sushil has conceded this fact, further stating that the recovery of weapon used in the incident has already been effected, therefore, custodial interrogation of the petitioners is not required. He has further stated that none of the petitioners has got any past criminal record.

It being so, the interim bail granted to the petitioners, vide order dated 19.03.2020 is made absolute, subject to the following conditions:-

- 1. that the petitioners shall make themselves available for investigation by a police officer as and when required;
- 2. that they shall not directly or indirectly make any inducement, threat or promise to any person acquainted with the facts of the case so as to dissuade him from disclosing such facts to the Court or to any police officer and;
- 3. that they shall not leave India without prior permission of the Court.
- 4. that they shall surrender their passports before the Investigating Officer and if they are not having passports, then, shall file the affidavits in that regard.

In case, the petitioners violate any terms & conditions, on which the bail has been granted to them , the prosecution would be entitled to apply for cancellation of bail.

The petition stands allowed accordingly.
