This writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for issuance of a writ of Mandamus directing respondent No. 2/Chief Administrator, HSVP, Panchkula to take a final decision within stipulated period on the combined proposal for approval of allotment of alternative plots.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that a similar matter i.e. CWP-12008-2017 was disposed of by this Court vide judgment dated 26.05.2017. He states that he will be satisfied in case the instant petition is disposed of in terms of judgment dated 26.05.2017 passed in CWP-12008-2017.

Learned State counsel states that he has no objection in case the prayer is allowed.

In CWP-12008-2017, this Court had passed the following

Having heard learned counsel for the petitioner and considering the nature of prayer made in this writ petition, we dispose of the same with a direction to the Chief Administrator, HUDA, Panchkula and the Estate Officer concerned, Gurugram, to entertain the petitioner's grievance and if it is a fact that the authorities are unable to deliver possession of Plot No. 1375, Sector-51, Gurugram, let petitioner's claim for allotment of an undisputed alternative plot including those referred to above, be considered within a period of two months from the date of receiving a certified copy of this order.

Ordered accordingly.

Meanwhile, no third party rights shall be created in respect of plot Nos. 197 & 193 in Sector-28 and Plot No. 601 in Sector-43, Gurugram

In view of the above, the present petition is disposed of in terms of judgment dated 26.05.2017 passed in CWP-12008-2017 (ibid).
