The matter has been taken up through video conferencing on account of restrictions due to outbreak of COVID-19 pandemic.

Petitioner-Jaswant Rai stated to be aged 58 years, has filed the present writ petition *inter alia* with a prayer for setting aside the charge sheet dated 26.11.2018 (Annexure P-1) and supplementary charge sheet dated 18.05.2020 (Annexure P-2).

He therefore prays that petitioner would like to challenge the said order of punishment by filing a separate writ petition. In view of the above, no further orders are called for.
