The Court has been convened through video conferencing due to
Covid-19 pandemic.

Instant petition has been filed under Section 482 of the Code of
Criminal Procedure, 1973 for issuance of a direction to the official
respondents not to harass the petitioners specially when the petitioners have
no role to play as is evident from the representation dated 15.07.2019
(Annexure P-2) submitted by petitioner No.1 to the official respondents as
well as from the agreement dated 04.02.2019 (Annexure P-1) executed
between the respondent No.5 and Ritu Bhatia.

Before approaching this Court, petitioner No.1 submitted a
representation dated 15.07.2019 (Annexure P-2) to the official respondents.
Counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners would be satisfied in

case a direction is issued to the concerned official respondent to look into the same.

Without expressing any opinion on the allegations made in the petition or in the representation, the petition is disposed of with a direction to Senior Superintendent of Police, Moga, District Moga, respondent No.4 to examine the representation dated 15.07.2019 (Annexure P-2) submitted by the petitioner No.1 and thereafter to take appropriate steps as warranted in accordance with law.

A copy of the representation dated 15.07.2019 (Annexure P-2) be communicated to respondent No.4 so as to enable him to do the needful expeditiously.
