HARNARESH SINGH GILL, J.

Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No. 0394 dated 23.07.2019 registered under Sections 120-B, 406, 420 and 506 IPC at Police Station Tauru, District Nuh-Mewat.

Counsel for the petitioner states that there is no specific allegations against the petitioner and no date or place has been mentioned in the FIR regarding the alleged transaction and has been falsely involved in the present case. The brother-in-law of the complainant is in Delhi Police. He further states that main accused Jamshed @ Monu has been arrested on 13.03.2021 and granted bail on the next date i.e. 14.03.2021 by learned JMJC, Mewat.

Learned State counsel assisted by learned counsel for the complainant pointed out that the recovery from the petitioner is yet to be effected, who along with co-accused committed online fraud. The petitioner is a habitual offender. One more FIR No. 456 dated 28.12.2019 under Sections 420, 406, 506 and 34 IPC at Police Station, Karol Bagh, Delhi is

registered against him. It is further stated that there cannot be any parity with co-accused Jamshed @ Monu, who had been arrested and granted bail by the Trial Court.

I have heard learned counsels for the parties.

The petitioner along with co-accused committed online fraud. The petitioner is a habitual offender. The petitioner has been involved in other case also, which clearly indicates towards his criminal antecedents. He does not deserve concession of the anticipatory bail.

In view of the above, the petition is dismissed.
