Prayer in the instant petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India, is for issuance of directions to respondents No.1 to 3 to provide protection of life and liberty to the petitioner.

Learned counsel contends that a civil dispute is admittedly pending between the petitioner and private respondents pertaining to his residential H. No.1184, Ground Floor, Housing Board Colony, Sector 23-A Faridabad. Learned counsel submits that despite it being in the knowledge of the Police Station, Mujessar, that a civil suit is pending between the parties, they are unnecessarily harassing and threatening the petitioner by summoning him to come to the Police Station time and again with the sole purpose to pressurize him to enter into a compromise with the private respondents.

Learned counsel has further submitted that inadvertently he could not place on record the copy of the summons received by the petitioner from the Police Station Mujessar along with the petition. He

seeks permission to place on record the copy of the summons. The same is taken on record, subject to all just exceptions, the Registry is directed to tag the same at appropriate place. Learned counsel further submits that after the receipt of the aforementioned summons he has been called number of times over the telephone by the Police Station.

Learned counsel has further submitted that he has also moved a representation dated 22.03.2021 (Annexure P-5) to respondent No.2-Commissioner of Police, Faridabad in the said regard, however, no steps have been initiated so far by the authorities concerned.

Learned counsel submits that he would be satisfied if directions are issued to respondent No.2 to look into the grievance of the petitioner and take necessary steps, if any required, in accordance with law.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court Ms. Tanushree Gupta, DAG Haryana accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents.

In view of the above, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2-Commissioner of Police, Faridabad, to look into the representation dated 22.03.2021 (Annexure P-5) at the earliest and take necessary steps, if any required, in accordance with law, to ensure that the life and liberty of the petitioners is not jeopardized.
