Matter has been taken up through video conferencing via Webex facility in the light of the Pandemic Covid-19 situation and as per instructions.

The present petition has been filed under Section 438 Cr.P.C for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in FIR No.88 dated 28.12.2019 registered under Sections 354-A, 376, 377, 406, 498-A, 506, 34 IPC at Women Police Station, District Rewari.

By virtue of the order dated 3.9.2021, the petitioner was directed to join investigation.

It has been contended by learned counsel for the petitioner that in pursuance to the order dated 3.9.2021, the petitioner has joined the investigation and fully cooperated and thus, the interim order may kindly be made absolute. However, counsel submits that he is not aware of the proceedings before the Mediation Centre.

Learned State counsel has endorsed the same and submitted that petitioner is no more required for further investigation.

In view of the above, the order dated 3.9.2021 is made absolute subject to the petitioner complying with the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. Petition stands allowed.

Parties are at liberty to carry on with their negotiations before the Mediation & Conciliation Centre of this Court.
