The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing in the light of the pandemic COVID-19 situation and as per instructions.

This Civil writ petition under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India has been filed for the issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus for directing respondent Nos. 2 to 4 to look into the matter and taking steps over the representation dated 15.01.2021 (Annexure P-4) moved by the petitioner.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that at this stage he would be satisfied, if a direction is issued to respondent No. 3-Deputy

Commissioner, Fazilka, to consider and decide the representation dated 15.01.2021 (Annexure P-4) expeditiously.

Heard.

A complete set of paper book has already been handed over to learned counsel for respondent Nos. 1 to 5.

In view of the above, without adverting to the merits of the case, the present petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 3-Deputy Commissioner, Fazilka to consider and decide the representation dated 15.01.2021 (Annexure P-4) within eight weeks from the receipt of the certified copy of the order. In case, on consideration, the competent authority reaches to the conclusion that the benefit claimed by the petitioner is admissible to him, in such eventuality, the consequential relief be allowed to him, within a period of eight weeks thereafter, in accordance with law. However, in case the competent authority feels that the relief claimed by the petitioner is not admissible or made out, in that case, a speaking order be passed in the matter.
