Prayer in the instant petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India, *inter alia*, is for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing respondent Nos.1 and 2 to consider the candidature of the petitioner for the advertised post dated 28.02.2020 (P-7) and on dated 28.02.2020 (P-8) of Master/Mistress Cadre Mathematics or Science whichever is available as she has already cleared selection examination conducted by the concerned authority and to issue her appointment letter as Master Cadre Mathematics or Science.

At the outset, learned counsel for the petitioner, on instructions, instead of pressing the present petition on merits, states that his client would be satisfied in case, representation dated 29.03.2021 (P-13) is considered and decided by passing a speaking order expeditiously.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court, Ms. Akshita Chauhan, AAG, Punjab, who is present through video-conference, accepts notice on behalf of respondent Nos.1 and 2, whereas, Mr. GBS Dhillon, Advocate, accepts notice on behalf of respondent No.3. Learned counsel for the respondents raise no objection against the innocuous prayer made on behalf of the petitioner.

In view of the agreed stand taken by both sides, but without going into the merits of the controversy, this writ petition is disposed off with direction to respondent No.3, to consider and decide the aforesaid representation dated 29.03.2021 (P-13), in accordance with law, by passing speaking order within a period of four weeks from today.
