By way of the instant petition, the petitioner has approached this Court for seeking the relief of the issuance of a writ in the nature of mandamus directing the respondents to take the final decision on her legal notice dated 02.03.2020 (Annexure P-20) and to release the family pension and arrears thereof to her along with interest thereon @ 18% per annum, while averring that her husband, who was employed with respondent No.1, died on 12.02.2004 and though she served the said legal notice to the respondents for seeking the afore-claimed benefits, but the same has not yet been decided.

Mr. S.S. Pannu, DAG, Haryana, has joined the proceedings on behalf of both the respondents in this case, in pursuance of the copies of this petition having been sent to the respondent-State in advance.

Heard.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner would be satisfied if a direction is given to respondent No.1 to look into and deal with/decide her said legal notice in a time bound manner.

Keeping in view the above-discussed prayer of learned counsel for the petitioner and without commenting upon the merits of the matter in hand, the instant writ petition is hereby disposed of with a direction to respondent No.1-Managing Director, Haryana Financial Corporation, to look into and deal with/decide the said legal notice of the petitioner (Annexure P-20), in accordance with law/relevant rules, by passing a speaking order thereon, within a period of two months from the date of receipt of the certified copy of this order.
