The Court has been convened through video conferencing due to Covid-19 Pandemic.

Instant petition has been filed under Section 438 of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.79 dated 22.09.2017, registered for offence under Section 21 of Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985 and Section 61 of Excise Act, 1914, at Police Station Sadar Sunam, District Sangrur.

At the outset, counsel for the petitioner does not want to press the petition. He submits that the petitioner will surrender before the trial Court and file a petition for grant of regular bail.

In case the petitioner surrenders before the trial Court within a period of one week from today and files a petition seeking grant of regular bail, the trial Court shall make an endeavour and decide the same within a period of three days from the date of its filing.

The petitioner shall deposit costs of Rs.10,000/- with the PGIMER, Poor Patient Welfare Fund, Sector 12, Chandigarh and furnish receipt of deposit before the trial Court along with the petition for grant of regular bail.

Petition is disposed of.
