1. The petitioner has approached this Court seeking grant of anticipatory bail in respect of a case registered against him vide FIR No.0037 dated 03.03.2020 at Police Station Dhariwal, District Gurdaspur, under Sections 420/465/467/468/471/201 & 120-B IPC.
2. The allegations in nutshell against the petitioner are to the effect that he was an attesting witness to the 'Will', which is alleged to be forged by the accused Harpal Singh.
3. Learned State counsel has informed that that pursuant to interim directions issued by this Court, the petitioner has since joined investigation and that during the course of investigation, he has

been found to be innocent and that challan against the co-accused already stands presented.

4. In view of the aforestated position, the petition is rendered infructuous and the same is disposed of as such.
