CWP No. 8082 of 2021

The petitioners are aggrieved because 'Mode of Partition' dated 08.02.2012 has been set aside by the Divisional Commissioner, Patiala Division, Patiala vide order dated 16.07.2013. Appeal against the said order has been dismissed by the Financial Commissioner Revenue vide order dated 05.12.2019.

It is contended that land comprised in Khasra No. 362 and 363 has been directed to be equally distributed amongst the parties, however, the said land being more valuable and being in possession of the petitioners since the year 1970, they should be compensated for the loss.

A perusal of the order of the learned Financial Commissioner shows that the matter has been remitted to the Assistant Collector 1st Grade, Patiala for final decision of 'Mode of Partition'. Some other directions have also been given.

Thus, the writ petition is disposed of with a direction that while ordering 'Mode of

Partition' afresh, the Assistant Collector 1st Grade shall consider all issues raised by the parties regarding the provision of equal value of land.
