The matter has been taken up through video-conferencing on account of outbreak of pandemic COVID-19.

Petitioners have come in this civil writ petition under Articles 226/227 of Constitution of India praying for issuance of writ in the nature of *mandamus* directing the respondents to grant the equal pay scale to the level of Rs.28,080/- like Guest JBT Teachers granted vide letter dated 22.06.2020 (Annexure P-4) alongwith all consequential benefits in view of the instructions dated 03.11.2017 (Annexure P-1) issued by the respondents.

Upon hearing learned counsel for the petitioners and perusal of the records, the petition stands disposed off with directions that petitioners shall first move representation for redressal of their grievance before the competent authority and upon receipt of the same, the same shall be disposed off by passing a speaking order, preferably, within a period of two months from the date of receipt of copy of representation with this order.
