Prayer in this petition is for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner in FIR No. 001 dated 02.01.2020, registered under Section 420 of the IPC at Police Station Shri Hargobindpur, District Batala.

The operative part of the order dated 02.07.2021, vide which the petitioner has been granted interim bail, is reproduced below:

“Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that husband of the petitioner is presently abroad and there are vague allegations of handing over money to the petitioner, without specifying any date, time or month.

Notice of motion for 08.09.2021.”

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner, in pursuance to the order dated 02.07.2021, has already appeared before the SHO/Investigating Officer and has joined the investigation.

Learned counsel for the State, on instructions from SI Saab Singh, has not disputed the factual position and submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is no more required for any further investigation.

Learned State counsel further submits that later on, a cancellation report was prepared and the same has been approved by the S.P. (D) and the same will be presented before the Illaqua Magistrate in due course.

In view of the above, the present petition is allowed and the interim bail granted to the petitioner, vide order dated 02.07.2021, is made absolute subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.
