Petitioner has come in this civil writ petition under Articles 226/227 of Constitution of India praying for issuance of writ in the nature of *mandamus* directing the respondent No. 4 to decide the case No. 623/2017 filed by the petitioner, in a time bound manner, under the Punjab Security of Land Tenures Act, 1953 against the respondents No. 5 to 22 for eviction from the illegal possession upon a pond in Gram Panchayat Rajheri, Teshil Radaur, District Yamuna Nagar.
