Case taken up through video conferencing.

The petitioner is seeking anticipatory bail in FIR No. 24 dated 27.02.2021, under Sections 458, 323, 148 and 149 of the Indian Penal Code, 1860, registered at Police Station Boha, District Mansa.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has been attributed simple injuries with a 'gandasi'. He also contends that the parties are residents of the same village and the matter has been compromised with the intervention of the respectables. He has filed a copy of the compromise, which is taken on record.

This Court, by the order dated 29.04.2021, had directed the petitioner to appear before the Investigating Officer and join the investigation and in the event of his arrest, he was ordered to be released on ad-interim bail to the satisfaction of the Investigating/Arresting Officer, subject to the conditions envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Learned State counsel, on instructions from ASI Hardev Singh, states that the petitioner has joined investigation.

In view of the above and the petitioner having joined investigation, the order dated 29.04.2021 granting interim bail to the petitioner is made absolute.

However, the petitioner shall abide by the conditions stipulated under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C. He shall also join investigation as and when called upon to do so.

The petition stands disposed of.
