1. Case is being taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing due to Covid-19 pandemic.

2. Learned Counsel contends that the instant petition was filed for initiating action against the respondents for failure to comply with order dated 26.03.2018 in CWP No-10897-2017 but pursuant to the filing of the instant petition, the respondents passed order dated 25.06.2021 re-fixing the pay of the petitioners though the same was not as per entitlement, therefore in the circumstances, the petitioners are not interested in pursuing the instant petition and the same may be disposed of as such while granting liberty to the petitioners to challenge re-fixation of the pay of the petitioners by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.

3. The same is not opposed to by the learned State counsel.

4. In view of the position noted above as well as the statement

of the learned counsel for the petitioners, the instant petition is disposed of as not calling for any action under the Contempt of Courts Act, 1971 against the respondents while granting liberty to the petitioners to challenge order dated 25.06.2021 by way of appropriate proceedings in accordance with law.
