Main case

The petitioner has sought alternative relief to appear in online
examination of Professional Ethics and Professional Accountability
(Subject Code 4746) alongwith the students of old batches, examination of
which was to be conducted on 19.04.2021.

On 09.04.2021, the following order was passed:-

“It is the case of the petitioner that the paper of Professional

Ethics and Professional Accountability (Subject Code-4746) for the 6th Semester is to take place on 19.04.2021 for the students who missed their Theory Subject Paper in September, 2020 for the examination which has been held online. It is her case that while sitting in the said examination in September, 2020, she had wrongly uploaded the answer-sheet of Drafting, Pleadings and Conveyancing (4745), due to which her result was shown as 'Result Later', as per Annexure P-6/A. She had also filed a representation dated 26.11.2020 (Annexure P-8) that her copy/email of hard copies of the answer-sheet be accepted, which is stated to have been filed as per communication dated 02.02.2021 (Annexure P-12).

It is in such circumstances, she seeks the interim relief for sitting in the forthcoming examination, so that her six months are not wasted.

Notice of motion for 28.04.2021.

Mr. Arun Bakshi, Advocate has put in appearance on behalf of the respondents and has sought time.

However, keeping in view the urgency of the matter, the petitioner be permitted to sit in the said examination, to be conducted on 19.04.2021, subject to the final decision of the present writ petition.

Copy of this order be given to the counsel for the parties under the signatures of the Special Secretary of this Court.

The respondent-University as such has filed a short reply that the petitioner has been allowed to sit in the examination on 19.04.2021. It has been further averred that before listing of the case she had been telephonically informed regarding permission to sit in the said examination.

The contention of the counsel for the petitioner now is that in view of the interim order, the result has not been declared.

Accordingly, the University shall declare the result of the

petitioner of the said examination and give the necessary benefits to the petitioner, in case she has cleared the said paper. The Detailed Marks Certificate be also supplied to her within a period of two weeks from the receipt of certified copy of this order, so that she can take benefit of the same for further advancement of her educational/professional career.

The writ petition stands disposed of.
