This Criminal Writ Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India has been moved by petitioners for issuance of a writ in the nature of Mandamus directing respondents No.1 to 3 to protect the life and liberty of petitioners at the hands of private respondents and to take action on representations dated 01.03.2021 and 18.03.2021 (Annexure P-7).

Learned counsel for the petitioners contended that petitioners have already made representations on 01.03.2021 and 18.03.2021 to Senior Superintendent of Police (Rural), Ludhiana, copies of which are available on the file as Annexure P/7, but still no action has been taken.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 3 only.

At the asking of Court, Mr. Mehardeep Singh, Additional Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 3. Complete copy of paper book has been supplied to him.

In view of above, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.2 – Senior Superintendent of Police (Rural), Ludhiana, to look into and decide representations dated 01.03.2021 and 18.03.2021 (Annexure P/7) in accordance with law by passing speaking order and that too within six weeks positively from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
