The petitioner in the present writ petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeks directions for consideration for promotion to the post of TGT Sanskrit from the date when their juniors have been promoted, with all consequential benefits.

Counsel submits that a legal notice dated 22.12.2020 (Annexure P-11) has already been served upon the respondents for the necessary relief, but no action has been taken on the same.

Mr. Shivendra Swaroop, AAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and submits that copy of the petition has not been supplied to him.

Counsel for the petitioners undertakes to supply soft copy of the petition to him during the course of the day.

Keeping in view the above facts, no useful purpose will be served to call upon the respondents for filing reply, as it would only delay the decision making.
