Petitioner has filed this petition under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail in a case FIR No.31 dated 02.03.2021 under Sections 22 and 29 NDPS Act, 1985, registered at Police Station Sadar Dhuri, District Sangrur. The petitioner apprehended his arrest at the hands of Police, in the above FIR.

On 15.07.2021, the following order was passed by this Court:

“.....Learned counsel for the petitioner has contended that the alleged contraband (2100 tablets containing Tramadol Hydrochloride-100 SR) was recovered from his co-accused-Bikkar Singh, who was arrested on the spot. According to learned counsel, subsequently on his statement, the petitioner has been implicated as an accused.

Notice of motion for 27.07.2021 ”

Thereafter on 27.07.2021, the interim protection was extended to the petitioner.

Learned State counsel, who is assisted by ASI Jagar Singh, has stated that the petitioner has joined the investigation and is not required for custodial interrogation for the time being.

Considering above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 27.07.2021 is made absolute.
