The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail under Section 438 Cr.P.C in case bearing FIR No.323 dated 17.11.2020 registered under Section 406 IPC, 1860 at Police Station Division No.5, Ludhiana.

Learned State counsel submits that the petitioner has joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

Learned counsel for the complainant however, opposed

the bail on the ground that the petitioner has pocketed the amount after withdrawal from different banks being nominee of his father. It appears that dispute is between son and step mother in respect of the amount left by Parminderjit Singh after his death. Evidently the complainant has already resorted to civil litigations in Court of law which are still subjudice.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Sukhpal Singh admitted the aforesaid fact and submitted that the petitioner is no more required for further investigation of the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 08.04.2021 is made absolute. Petitioner shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and he shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
