The case is taken up through video conferencing on account of COVID 2019.

CWP-19899-2019, filed by petitioners was disposed of vide order dated 22.7.2019 with a direction to respondent No. 3 to protect the lives and liberty of petitioners from private respondents arrayed in the writ petition.

It was claimed by petitioners that they had married against the wishes of private respondents, hence, they were apprehending danger to their lives and liberty from the family of petitioner No. 2.

Learned counsel for petitioners contends that petitioner No. 2 was assaulted by private respondents on 31.3.2021 because of which petitioner No. 2 received multiple injuries including head injury. Petitioners made a representation dated 5.4.2021 addressed to respondents No. 2 and 3 regarding assault and injury caused to petitioner No. 2 by respondents on 31.3.2021.

Reply/affidavit on behalf of respondent No. 2 has been filed wherein it is stated that apart from the opposition of marriage, there are certain private disputes between petitioners and private respondents in the writ petition. After receipt of representation dated 5.4.2021, a calandra under Sections 107, 151 Cr.P.C. has been prepared.

In view thereof, it cannot be said that there is violation of the directions.
