Prayer in the instant petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, is for issuance of directions to the official respondents to provide protection of life and liberty to the petitioners at the hands of private respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that the petitioners are distantly related to the husband of respondent No.5 are time and again subjected to harassment by respondent No.5 in collusion with the police authorities inasmuch as petitioner No.1 who is a senior citizen is being called to the Police Station for no rhyme or reason. He further submits that all this is being done because respondent No.5 has strained relations with her husband who is stated to be residing in United States of America. It has been submitted that in this regard petitioners have made representations (Annexures P-1 to P-3) to the concerned authorities.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners would be satisfied if a direction is issued to respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar (Mohali), Punjab to look into their representation/complaint dated 26.02.2021 (Annexure P-3).

Notice of motion.

On asking of the Court, Mr. Luvinder Sofat, Assistant Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents-State.

Keeping in view the submissions made by the learned counsel for the petitioners, respondent No.3-Senior Superintendent of Police, SAS Nagar (Mohali), Punjab is directed to look into the representation/complaint dated 26.02.2021 (Annexure P-3) of the petitioners *qua* the threat perception and take appropriate steps/action, if any required under the provisions of law.

The petition is disposed of accordingly.
