HARNARESH SINGH GILL, J.

The petitioner seeks grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No. 251 dated 30.03.2016 registered at Police Station Sadar Hisar, District Hisar, under Sections 406, 420, 467, 468, 471, 120-B IPC.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has falsely been implicated in the above noted FIR and that liability, if any, is civil in nature.

However, a reading of the FIR makes it clear that the petitioner was the stockiest and he had intentionally provided the goods belonging to the complainant to one Shivraj Agency, which was a forged firm and as a matter of fact, no such firm was into existence.

The petitioner had been in constant business relations with the complainant since 2014. On assurance from the petitioner, the complainant had acted under the belief that the goods would be sold as per the assurance given. Therefore, it is apparent that the petitioner has defeated the very fiduciary relationship between the complainant and the petitioner.

In view of the above, no case is made out for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

Hence, the present petition is dismissed.
