This petition has been filed by the petitioner under Section 438 Code of Criminal Procedure for grant of anticipatory bail in case FIR No.0187 dated 12.03.2020 under Section 21 Narcotic Drugs and Psychotropic Substances Act, 1985, registered at Police Station City Sirsa, District Sirsa, Haryana. The petitioner apprehended his arrest at the hands of Police, in the above FIR.

There is no representation on behalf of the petitioner.

This Court while issuing notice of motion to the respondent-State on 20.03.2020 had extended the interim protection to the petitioner.

The said order reads as under:-

“Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the alleged contraband weighing 9.45 grams (heroin) was recovered from co-accused Gaurav @ Goru. At the time of recovery, the petitioner was not present at the spot, who was indicted on the basis of the statement given by the said accused. According to

the learned counsel his custodial interrogation may not be necessary.

Notice of motion for 21.07.2020.

Meanwhile, the petitioner shall join the investigation and would come present as and when called for and in the event of arrest, the petitioner shall be admitted to interim bail on his furnishing personal and surety bonds to the satisfaction of Arresting/Investigating Officer. The petitioner shall also abide by the conditions as specified under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.”

Learned State counsel, who is assisted by ASI Krishan Kumar does not dispute this fact that the petitioner has joined the investigation and he is not required for custodial interrogation for the time being.

Considering the above, the petition is allowed and the interim bail granted by this Court vide order dated 20.03.2020 is made absolute.
