The case has been taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

Petitioners seek grant of anticipatory bail in case bearing FIR No.110 dated 27.03.2021 registered under Sections 147, 149, 323, 384, 427 and 506 IPC at Police Station Sector 56, Gurugram District Gurugram.

On 09.04.2021, following order was passed by this Court:-

"The case has been taken up for hearing through video-conferencing.

Learned counsel for the petitioners contends that in the facts and circumstances of the case, offences except offences under Sections 384 & 506 IPC are bailable. Offence

under Section 384 IPC is not attracted as no amount was delivered to the petitioners in furtherance of the threat given by them. No medical record has come forth showing the allegations of given beatings by danda. The Additional Sessions Judge, Gurugram in his order dated 06.04.2021 has recorded that Sh. Vikram Yadav, Advocate had appeared on behalf of the complainant and a compromise was effected between the parties and the complainant is not interested in pursuing the case anymore.

In the meanwhile, petitioners are directed to appear before the SHO/Investigating Officer to join investigation on 16.04.2021 at 11:00 AM and in the event of their arrest, they shall be enlarged on ad interim bail, on their furnishing requisite bail bonds/surety bonds subject to the satisfaction of Arresting Officer. However, petitioners shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2) Cr.P.C.

Nothing expressed hereinabove shall be construed to be an opinion on the merits of the case. The case shall be decided on merits on the adjourned date.”

Learned counsel for the petitioners submitted that in compliance of order dated 09.04.2021, the petitioners have joined the investigation to the entire satisfaction of the Investigating Officer.

Learned State counsel on instructions from HC Amarjeet admitted the aforesaid fact and submitted that the petitioners are no more required for further investigation of the case.

In view of aforesaid factual position, the interim order dated 09.04.2021 is made absolute. Petitioners shall keep on joining the investigation as and when required to do so and they

shall abide by the conditions as envisaged under Section 438(2)
Cr.P.C.

Petition stands disposed of.
