Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

This is the third petition under Section 438 Cr.P.C. for grant of pre-arrest bail to the petitioner in case FIR No.110 dated 07.09.2020 registered under Sections 452, 323, 506 read with Section 34 IPC and Section 308 IPC (added later on), at Police Station Badali Ala Singh, District Fatehgarh Sahib, the first one having been dismissed as withdrawn on 01.10.2020 and the second one dismissed on merits vide order dated 10.03.2021 passed by this Court.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contends that the petitioner has falsely been implicated by the complainant and that earlier, ASI Sadhu Khan had misled the Court and that is why he has been impleaded as respondent No.3 herein.

Learned counsel for the petitioner further contends that the complainant and his family members are in the habit of getting false

complaints/DDR/FIRs registered against the innocent persons by suffering self-inflicted injuries.

Earlier, vide order dated 10.03.2021 passed by this Court, the second bail application filed by the petitioner was dismissed by observing that the petitioner, in connivance with other co-accused, had inflicted injuries on the persons of the complainant, his father and brother. There were specific allegations against the petitioner of having caused injuries on the forehead, head, eyes and nose of the injured-Gurjit Singh. Even the injury inflicted on the left eye of injured-Gurjit Singh was declared grievous in nature.

There is no change of circumstance. As referred to above, the position remains the same as was noticed in the order dated 10.03.2021.

Therefore, finding no merit petition, the same is hereby dismissed.
