The petitioner in the present writ petition filed under Articles 226/227 of the Constitution of India seeks directions for permitting him to continue as Special Police Officer, on the ground that he has been declared medically fit by the Medical Board of PGIMS, Rohtak on 25.02.2021 (Annexure P-4).

Counsel has submitted that the petitioner in pursuance of an advertisement issued in July, 2020 had applied against 65 posts of Special Police Officers, being an ex-serviceman. He had been allotted Belt No.310 by respondent No.3-Superintendent of Police, Rohtak and on 13.08.2020 (Annexure P-1) was sent to the Civil Surgeon for medical check-up. He had been declared unfit on 09.10.2020 (Annexure P-2) and, thereafter, his case has been referred to the Medical Board and the examination has, thus, been conducted and certificate has been issued on 25.02.2021 (Annexure P-4), whereby he has been declared fit for Class-III post. It is submitted that in spite of the said fact, he has not been

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allowed to join. It is further submitted that a representation dated 22.03.2021 (Annexure P-5) has been made to the Chief Minister of Haryana through CM Window.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Shivendra Swaroop, AAG, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of the respondents and submits that copy of the petition has not been supplied to him.

Counsel for the petitioners undertakes to supply soft copy of the petition to him during the course of the day.

Keeping in view the fact that since the decision making is still incomplete, no useful purpose will be served to call upon the respondents for filing reply, as it would only delay the proceedings.

Accordingly, without commenting upon the merits or entitlement of the petitioner, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.3 to take a decision on the above said representation of the petitioner dated 22.03.2021 (Annexure P-5), within a period of two months from the receipt of the certified copy of this order. In case, there is any legal impediment, reasoned order be passed and communicated to the petitioner forthwith.
