In the present writ petition filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India the petitioners seeks consideration for appointment to the post of Art & Craft Teacher against the Advertisement No.6/2006 for which they have been held ineligible.

Petitioner No.1-Krishan Kumar is stated to have submitted the DMC dated 14.08.2006 for Diploma in Art and Craft of 2 years, the essential eligibility which was before the cut-off-date i.e. 21.08.2006, but the DMC marks have not been mentioned and it pertains to the first year only.

A perusal of the certificate appended by the State goes on to show that there was a re-appear in a subject till May, 2007 and that he passed the examination in November, 2006 as per another certificate dated 02.03.2007. Thus, it is apparent that petitioner No.1 was not qualified by the cut-off-date. Similarly, qua petitioner No.2 his diploma is dated 02.03.2007 for the examination held in November, 2006 which is after the cut-off-date and, therefore, he has been held ineligible.

Accordingly, there is no merit in the present writ petition and the same is dismissed.
