The case has been taken up for hearing through
video conferencing.

This is a petition under Section 439(2) read with
Section 482 Cr.P.C. seeking cancellation of bail granted to
respondent No.2-complainant in FIR No.323 dated 11.10.2017
under Sections 306, 34 IPC, Police Station Salem Tabri, District
Ludhiana.

Petitioners seek cancellation of bail granted to
respondent No.2 vide order dated 24.08.2018 whereby interim
order dated 02.02.2018 was made absolute.

Learned State counsel on instructions from ASI Prem Singh submits that the police has already prepared a cancellation report and the same would be placed before the Illaqa Magistrate very shortly.

Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioners submits that they would avail their legal remedies in the event of filing cancellation report before the Illaqa Magistrate in accordance with law including filing of protest petition (if any).

In view of aforesaid facts, this petition is disposed of.
