This Criminal Writ Petition under Article 226 of the Constitution of India is for issuance of direction to respondents No.1 to 4 to protect the life and liberty of petitioner and his family members at the hands of respondents No.5 and 6.

Learned counsel for the petitioner contended that previously, petitioner had moved representation on 21.11.2019 to respondent No.3-Commissioner of Police, Amritsar, vide UID No.1695744 and, thereafter, petitioner has moved representation on 23.02.2021 afresh to respondent No.3-Commissioner of Police, Amritsar, copies of which are available on the file as Annexures P/1 and P/3 respectively, but still no action has been taken.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 4 only.

At the asking of Court, Mr. Mehardeep Singh, Additional Advocate General, Punjab, accepts notice on behalf of respondents No.1 to 4. Complete copy of paper book has been supplied to him.

In view of above, the present petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.3-Commissioner of Police, Amritsar, to look into and decide representation dated 23.02.2021 (Annexure P/3) in accordance with law by passing speaking order and that too within eight weeks positively from the date of receipt of copy of this order.
