LISA GILL, J.

This matter is being taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to the outbreak of pandemic, COVID-19.

The grievance raised by the petitioner is that despite having secured 62 marks in the written examination as per his self-assessment and being called for scrutiny of documents, his name is not reflected in the select list. The last candidate selected to the post of Pharmacist, in the category of ESM (SC), pursuant to advertisement dated 07.09.2019, it is stated, has secured 48 marks.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Ashish Yadav, Addl. A.G., Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of all the respondents. Learned counsel for the respondents, to whom an advance copy of the petition has supplied, submits that petitioner has not

even approached the authorities and has straight away filed this writ petition.

In case a representation is filed, the same shall be decided expeditiously.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of the case as noted above, but without any expression of opinion on merits of the matter, this writ petition is disposed of with a direction that the present writ petition be treated as a representation on behalf of the petitioner and competent authority to take a final decision thereon, within a period of three weeks from receipt of certified copy of this order.

Petition is disposed of accordingly.
