LISA GILL, J.

This matter is being taken up for hearing through video conferencing due to the outbreak of pandemic, COVID-19.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that the petitioner's husband was appointed on daily wage with the respondent-Department in 1980. His services were regularized on 04.05.1993 and he retired from service on 29.02.2016. Petitioner's husband is stated to have died on 23.06.2016. Prayer in this petition is for counting of daily wage service of petitioner's husband towards the total length of service for the purpose of pensionary/retiral benefits. In this respect, it is submitted that legal notice dated 11.03.2021 (Annexure P3) has been served upon the respondents but to no avail.

At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioner restricts his prayer for a decision on the legal notice dated 11.03.2021 (Annexure P3), in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion.

Mr. Ashish Yadav, Addl. A.G., Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of all the respondents. Advance copy of the writ petition stands served. Learned counsel for the State does not raise any serious objection to the limited prayer addressed.

Keeping in view the facts and circumstances of this case, but without any expression of opinion on the merits of the matter, this petition is disposed of with a direction to the competent authority to consider and decide legal notice dated 11.03.2021 (Annexure P3), within a period of three months from receipt of certified copy of this order.

Petition is disposed of accordingly.
