The grievance of the petitioner is that the Panchayat is threatening to demolish a part of his residential house situated in Khasra No.627 by illegally declaring that part thereof is in Khasra No.625, which is Gram Panchayat land. A demarcation report is being relied upon for this purpose but the petitioner was never associated with the said demarcation. Thus, he has submitted a representation dated 05.03.2021 (Annexure P-8) to respondent No.4 asking for a fresh demarcation in his presence but no action has been taken thereupon till date.

Learned counsel for the petitioner submits that a direction may be given to respondent No.4 to decide the pending representation dated 05.03.2021 (Annexure P-8) in accordance with law and in a time bound manner.

Notice of motion to respondents No.1 to 4 only.

Mr. Charanpreet Singh, AAG, Punjab accepts notice on behalf of the respondents No.1 to 4 and waives service.

Considering the nature of the order being passed there is no necessity of filing a written statement.

The writ petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No. 4 to decide the pending representation dated 05.03.2021 (Annexure P-8) by passing a speaking order within eight weeks from the date of receipt of certified copy of this order.
