Case is taken up for hearing through video conferencing.

This petition has been filed for quashing of FIR No.152 dated 11.06.2019 registered under Sections 279, 304-A IPC, Sections 3/181 and 146/196 of the Motor Vehicles Act, along with all consequential proceedings arising therefrom, qua the petitioner only.

Learned counsel for the petitioner states that the petitioner is the owner of Maxi Truck, which was sold to Vinod Singh on 07.06.2019. Vinod Singh had executed an affidavit, which was not taken into consideration by the investigating agency while presenting the challan.

However, this Court finds that the present petition is not maintainable as the challan stands already presented and any grievance of the petitioner in that regard, can only be dealt with the Court seized of the proceedings.

Faced with this situation, learned counsel for the petitioner prays to withdraw the present petition with the liberty to avail his remedy, as per law.

Dismissed as withdrawn with the liberty aforesaid.
