Case has been taken up for hearing through Video Conferencing.

This petition under Section 482 Cr.P.C. has been moved for issuance of direction to respondents to treat Ishwar Rani wife of Joginder Singh (mother of petitioner), who is confined in Central Jail, Ambala in case FIR No.243 dated 24.08.2019 under Sections 406, 420, 467, 468, 471 and 506 IPC read with Section 34 IPC (Section 120-B IPC added lateron), registered at Police Station Farakpur, District Yamuna Nagar.

Learned counsel for the petitioner *inter alia* contends that mother of petitioner is 70% disabled and unable to sit and she is suffering from hypertension, migraine and depression but she is not being provided proper treatment by the jail authorities.

At the asking of Court, Mr. Mehardeep Singh, Additional Advocate General, Haryana, accepts notice on behalf of respondents. Complete copy of paper book has been supplied to him.

Having heard learned counsel for the parties, instant petition is disposed of with the direction to respondent No.4-Superintendent, Central Jail, Ambala, District Ambala, to provide requisite medical assistance to under trial—Ishwar Rani wife of Joginder Singh (mother of petitioner).
