The hearing of the case was held through video conferencing on account of restricted functioning of the Courts.

This civil writ petition has been filed under Article 226/227 of the Constitution of India for issuance of a writ in the nature of certiorari for quashing the order dated 05.04.2021 (Anexure P-1).

Learned counsel representing the petitioner contends that the petitioner has been shown to have been transferred on mutual consent with Dr. Mohit Bharti, however, no such consent was even given by her.

Before filing this writ petition, the petitioner is stated to have sent a representation to the Principal Secretary, Department of Health & Family Welfare, Government of Punjab, Civil Secretariat, Sector-1, Chandigarh.

Keeping in view the aforesaid facts, it is considered appropriate to dispose of the writ petition with direction to Principal Secretary, Department of Health & Family Welfare, Government of Punjab, Civil Secretariat, Chandigarh to consider and decide the representation by passing a speaking order after granting an opportunity to the petitioner, within a period of three weeks.
