Prayer in the instant petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India, is for issuance of directions to respondents No.2 and 3 to provide protection of life and liberty to the petitioners, who have married against the wishes of private respondents.

Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that petitioner No.1 -Navneet Kaur aged about 23 years and petitioner No.2-Narinderjeet aged about 26 years have got married on 07.04.2021, against the wishes of their family members, arrayed as respondent Nos.4 and 5. He submits that it is the first marriage of both the petitioners. It has been further submitted that the private respondents are threatening to interfere in the marital life of the petitioners. Hence, they are seeking protection in that regard and have approached this Court by way of filing the instant petition.

Learned counsel for the petitioners has submitted that they have sent a representation dated 07.04.2021 (Annexure P-5) in this regard to respondent No.2-Senior Superintendent of Police, District Patiala.

On a pointed query put to the learned counsel for the petitioners

as to the mode through which the said representation was sent to the concerned authorities, she has apprised this Court that it was sent through courier. In support of her submissions, learned counsel has sent the copy of receipt of the courier service on Whatsapp group, through which the representation was made to the authorities concerned. The same is taken on record, subject to all just exceptions. Office to tag the same at the appropriate place.

Notice of motion.

On the asking of the Court Mr. Luvinder Sofat, AAG, Punjab, who is appearing through video conferencing, accepts notice on behalf of the official respondents.

In view of the above, the petition is disposed of with a direction to respondent No.2–Senior Superintendent of Police, Patiala, to look into the representation dated 07.04.2021 (Annexure P-5) at the earliest and take necessary steps, if any required, in accordance with law, to ensure that the life and liberty of the petitioners is not jeopardized at the hands of the private respondents. However, this direction will not validate the marriage said to have taken place between the parties and will have no effect on any civil or criminal action, which could be initiated in the matter in accordance with law.
